Itinerary

Day 1 *Welcome Leadership Ambassadors!*

- b. Enjoy the **welcome launch** and opening address by the program leader.
- c. Get to know the teachers and staff who will guide you through the program
- d. Engage in your first student leadership meeting as you meet your fellow Leadership Ambassadors you review the exciting week ahead.

Day 2 *Challenge yourself to reach new heights*

- a. Examine **leadership characteristics** and discuss **the strengths of successful leaders** as you share your **pre-summit assignment** in your small group. Discover the four key steps to constructing your community-service action plan during your leadership group meeting.
- b. Push yourself to the limit during a hands-on **teambuilding challenge**.
- c. Practice your **active listening skills** with your team at your leadership meeting.

Day 3 *Make a habit of setting goals*

- a. Increase your self-confidence and interpersonal skills after attending the **7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens workshop**.
- b. Participate in a **university life presentation** as you gain insight into campus life and put together your own career wish list.
- c. Explore the **UCA/ UADE campus**.
- d. Be inspired to set new goals by a **motivational speaker**.

Day 4 Get out there: Buenos Aires!

- a. Explore Buenos Aires with a certified step-on guide, from the antiques streets of San Telmo to the bohemian Palermo areas.
- b. Snap pictures of the **famous places** and become a tango star for a moment in Abasto.
- c. Confront the issues of poverty and social differences around the city, and the world and learn how you can be an agent of change during a meeting with representatives of different NGOs involved in subject in BA.
- d. Relax at the famous **Puerto Madero and Reserva Ecológica** in the border of the River Plate.
- e. Sharpen your **conflict resolution** skills during your student leadership meeting.

Day 5 Make a difference

- a. Give back to the local community through a hands-on **community-service project** and earn 20 service learning hours.
- b. Discuss in your leadership group the **impact of serving a community** and gain insights to your own community service action project.
- c. **Analyze a leadership-themed movie** and discuss the leadership styles exhibited in the film.
- d. Learn about **CQ (cultural intelligence quotient)** and consider ways to live as a **global citizen** during your student leadership meeting.

Day 6 Share your Leadership in Action project

- a. **Present your community-service action plan** to your peers and teachers.
- b. Review your progress through an **academic evaluation** with your teacher leader.
- c. Celebrate and bond with your fellow Leadership Ambassadors.

Day 7 Farewell and departure

- a. In the morning, bid farewell to your new friends.
- b. Greet your family or take a private shuttle to the airport.
